## **Graduation Thesis**

Title: Urban transformation of Naviglio Grande Milano: A new museum system developed a new spatial sequence.

Thesis Summary: This project attempts to reconstruct the relationship between Naviglio Grande and its surrounding diverse elements, shaping a new museum system spatial sequence. The sustainable urban transformation is expected to be achieved through the development of the new museum spatial sequence which will be a part of the urban structure and landscape.

Abandoned urban spaces have always been neglected, leading to negative elements and ignoring the potential of the natural recourses. Thus, a new museum space sequence was proposed to redevelop the existing abandoned area. The current space sequence was redefined by the urban reading and writing methods.

The urban reading method has been used to analyze the limits, boundaries, borders and thresholds of trace layer and soil. The urban writing method plays an important role in regenerating spatial sequences by connecting dispersed urban public spaces with natural recourses, intervals and the urban texture.
